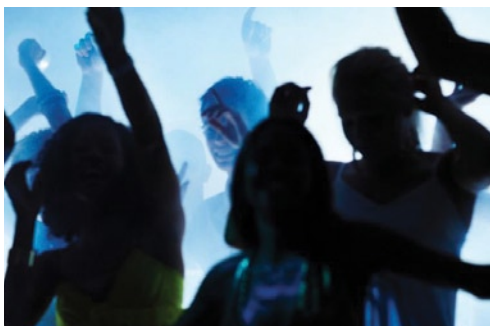

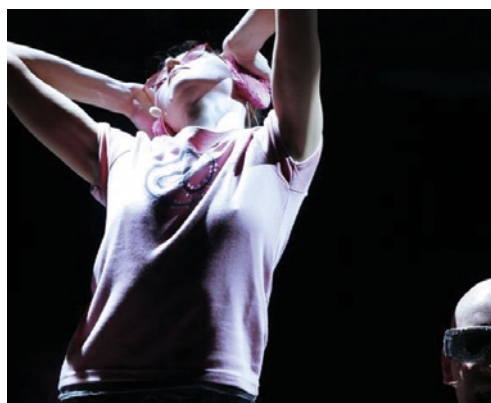


Fire Flyz Beginners Workshops
